

SAY YES MAMMOGRAM SCREENING PROGRAM

The "Say Yes" program is a plan of action that encourages women to "Say Yes" to their mammograms. It is open to all women, with special attention on those in under-resourced areas. Through the program, NJRMF helps with mammogram expenses, connection of resources while also making times and locations convenient for women in the community.

TRANSPORTATION

For some women there are barriers, such as transportation, that keep them from getting a mammogram. We provide rides for women that need safe travel to their appointments. This includes a ride to any additional testing or screening that may be needed after their initial mammogram.

SUPPORT FOR THE YOUTH

It is extremely important that young people are uplifted and exposed to opportunities that give them a chance to excel in the future. NJRMF helps elevate them by providing resources to assist graduating seniors with expenses for college, providing books to help kindergarten children with reading skills, and by supporting various educational opportunities.

IN THIS TOGETHER INITIATIVE

Since the onset of Covid, NJRMF has provided PPE supplies (masks, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, etc) to the breast evaluation and cancer treatment centers in the community. Cancer treatments did not cease during the pandemic, and patients receiving treatment have weakened immune systems and need extra special care and protection.

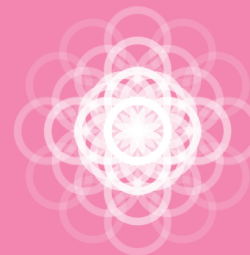

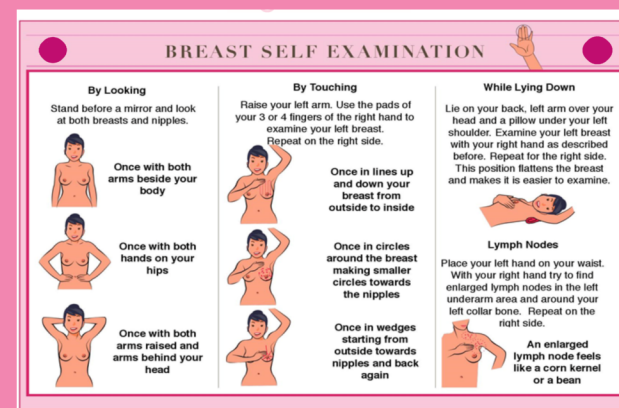

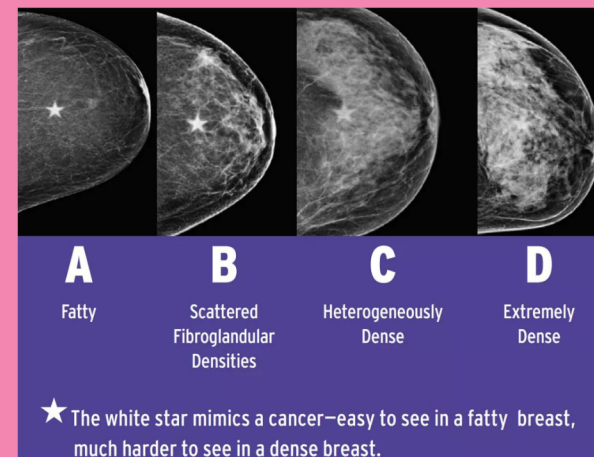
